Honors Courses

- ▶ Honors English 7 & Compacted Math 7: Students are selected for honors courses in ELA and math based on multiple criteria including academic history and benchmark/state assessment scores.
- ▶ Honors Early U.S. History: Students must have a 90 average or higher in Early World History.
- ▶ Honors Science 7: Students must have a 90 average or higher in Science 6.

Special Note:

- ▶ Some Sports/P.E. options require a tryout and have associated fees with participation.
- ▶ **NO** students will be placed in a sport/activity that requires a tryout until a list is received from the coach.
- ▶ If you sign up to participate in a sport, you must remain in that course for the remainder of the year. For example: If you choose football, you will remain in football even when the season is over.
- ▶ This does not include multisport athletes that will change sports with seasons.
