We have been alerted by MDE that, due to a
data submission error, students who were
not eligible to receive free or reduced lunch
through the National School Lunch Program
(NSLP) during the 2020-21 school year were
mailed a P-EBT card in error. P-EBT cards for
these ineligible students have been frozen
and funds cannot be accessed. Funds will
automatically be removed from these cards.
