

## 2021 Homecoming Parade Lineup Thursday September 30, 2021

Floats and other parade vehicles may begin arriving at the staging area no earlier than 4:30. Please enter the Hinds Campus from Country Place Parkway. They need to be in place **by 5:15**. Please see the map to know where your float will be staged. There will also be guidance as to where you will be staged as you arrive. Passes have been created and will be sent to the respective schools and other participants should pick up their pass in the attendance office of Pearl High School (Mrs. Bush will have them) any time after Tuesday 9/28/21. These MUST be visible in the windshield of any vehicle participating in the parade. ONLY VEHICLES WITH PASSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARK OR ENTER THE STAGING AREA.

Parade Participants can be dropped off at the Muse Center Parking Lot no earlier than 5:15 and need to be there and at their floats by 5:40. Parents will not be able to park in this area—it will be similar to a "car-rider line". (See map for details.) If a parent would like to park, they must do so in the adjoining parking lots (not pictured on map). Please enter the Hinds Campus from Country Place Parkway.

The access road that leads from the staging parking lots of Hinds to Pirate Cove will be closed at 5:35; no vehicles will be allowed down this road after 5:35. The Hwy 80 entrance of Pirate Cove will be closed at 5:35 and will reopen after the completion of the parade.

The Parade will start promptly at 5:45 and will continue down Pirate Cove to the entrance of the Main PHS Parking Lot (map attached). <u>Participants and the community are encouraged to continue to Ray Rogers</u> <u>Stadium for the Community Pep Rally</u>. Once in the parking lot, decorations that have been donated will be pulled off the floats and taken into the high school.
