Pearl Public School District will again offer drive-up grab and go summer meals 11:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m., Mondays – Fridays, May 31-June 30, 2022, at Pearl Lower Elementary. - User ID is student MSIS number, without any leading zeroes, followed by @students.pearlk12.com. Example: 1234567@students.pearlk12.com
- Student password is DOB, formatted as M/D/YYYY. Example: 8/1/2005
