Pearl Public School District will again offer drive-up grab and go summer meals 11:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m., Mondays – Fridays, May 31–June 30, 2022, at Pearl Lower Elementary. Children 18 and under will be provided a lunch and breakfast for the next day for free, curbside only. *Children must be present to claim their meal.*

Adults over the age of 18 can purchase meals (cash only). Lunch is \$3.75 and breakfast is \$2.25 or a total of \$6.00 for both meals. This institution is an equal opportunity provider.

How to login:

- Begin typing your school name, and it will appear in the dropdown box.
- User ID is student MSIS number, without any leading zeroes, followed by @students.pearlk12.com.
Example: 1234567@students.pearlk12.com
- Student password is DOB, formatted as M/D/YYYY.
Example: 8/1/2005
