All households are encouraged to submit a SY21/22 Free/Reduced Meal Application so that their students may qualify for other benefits offered. Go to www.myschoolapps.com to access the application.

Please remember to follow safety guidelines as we return to school.

- Face coverings are optional but encouraged inside PPSD buildings. All students and staff, regardless of vaccination status, should bring a mask to school that will be worn during small group instruction or group assignments when social distancing cannot be maintained. Mask up when huddled up!
- Because social distancing on a bus may be challenging, face coverings will be required on all PPSD buses.
- Wash your hands, often, with soap and water for 20 seconds, or the time it takes you to sing "Happy Birthday" twice. Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Don't touch your face if your hands are not clean.
- Practice social distancing. Keep 3 feet between you and others when possible.
